ITINERARY

The tour takes place over four days and four nights. We kick off in the Durbanville winelands where registration takes place and tour packs are handed out. After breakfast and a quick briefing, we hit the road inland.

20 May	DAY 3	Oudtshoorn to Swellendam	272 km
21 May	DAY 4	Swellendam to Hermanus	193 km

DAY 1 – SUNDAY 18 MAY CAPE TOWN TO MONTAGU

On day one, we depart from the Durbanville winelands and head east through the Boland, traversing the spectacular Bainskloof Pass which dates back to the 1850's. We travel over the Slanghoek drift before our lunch stop in the Breede River Valley.



We continue onto the famous Route 62 and enjoy the magnificent fold mountains of Cogmanskloof before arriving at our first night's stop, the Montagu Country Hotel where we will enjoy a luxurious dinner.



DAY 2 – MONDAY 19 MAY Montagu to Oudtshoorn

After a scrumptious breakfast we continue along Route 62 to Barrydale, where we visit the weavery, a local run business that is producing fabulous quality products while upskilling the residents of Barrydale.

We then continue through Ladismith and the Huisrivier Pass before arriving in the town of Oudtshoorn, the heart of the Klein Karoo, founded in 1857 and home to the world's largest population of ostriches.

Our accommodation for the night will be the luxurious Buffelsdrift Game Lodge, where we will enjoy a night away in the bush, including a wildlife experience and lapa dinner.







DAY 3 -TUESDAY 20 MAY OUDTSHOORN TO SWELLENDAM

Our third day will be the longest of the tour, as we head back along Route 62 before winding our way along Garcia's Pass over the Langeberg Mountain Range to the town of Riversdale.

We visit the Skeerhok Padstal for a light lunch or a piece of cake, before continuing onto Swellendam for the night. The town, being the third oldest in the country, is rich with history and its quaint Cape Dutch buildings.

We will be spoilt for dinner at a local fine dining restaurant, and enjoy a good night's rest at Aan de Eike Guest House.



DAY 4 – WEDNESDAY 21 MAY SWELLENDAM TO HERMANUS

Day four marks our final day on the tour. Our route takes us on a scenic drive through the Breerivier farmlands, before heading south to Bredasdorp for an early lunch or coffee stop.

We wind our way over the hills to Stanford, where participants will be able to visit the Birkenhead Brewery, Fynbos gin distillery or Stanford Hills Wine Estate. There



are also several fantastic coffee shops and restaurants in and around the town.

Finally, we head for Hermanus where we will be staying at the chic Auberge Burgundy Boutique Hotel. Our final night's dinner will see us celebrating four days on the road with fellow motoring enthusiasts and already looking forward to the next year's tour!
